I would like to remind you that Nell Gwynn and Ann Bernadt Nursery Schools will be participating in The **Tate Exchange Project** at **The Tate Modern** on **Tuesday 26th June, (12pm until 6pm)** and **Wednesday 27th June, (12pm until 4pm)**. Please note that your child's participation in the event will take place instead of attending nursery that day/s (**if it happens to coincide with the session they usually attend**).
